Walking poles are available for use by our members. Sign them out and enjoy.

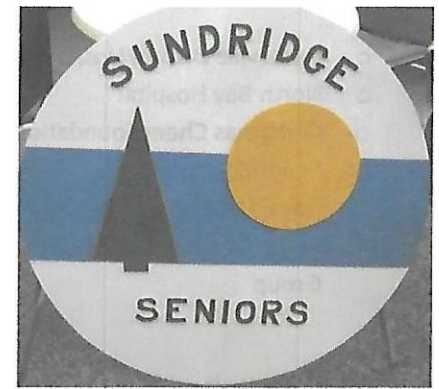
Chair Yoga
