Who we are:

We are a legal clinic staffed by lawyers, a community legal worker, and two support workers. Funded by Legal Aid Ontario.

Who we help:

We can help people who qualify financially and who live in the city of North Bay or the District of Nipissing.

What we do:

- ⇒ Residential Tenancies Act
- ⇒ Ontario Works
- ⇒ Criminal Injuries Compensation
- ⇒ Human rights (Advice Only)
- ⇒ Employment Insurance
- ⇒ Ontario Disability Support Program
- ⇒ Canada Pension Plan

We do Not do:

- ⇒ Family Law
- ⇒ Criminal Law
- ⇒ Estate Law
- ⇒ Employment Law

Because we cannot help people in all areas of the law we will try to refer you to someone who can.

Community Outreach:

We can speak to individuals and community groups about their rights.

How to get help:

If you telephone or drop into our office, a receptionist will ask you some questions and schedule an appointment for you or refer you to someone else who can better assist you.

Confidentiality:

Our services are confidential

Fees:

We do not charge for our service. However, there may be minor costs for expenses such as court fees or medical reports.

Membership:

This clinic is a non-profit corporation. We are governed by a Board of Directors. The members of the Board are elected by our membership at our Annual General Meeting. If you are 18 or older and live in the area served by the clinic, you are eligible to become a member.
